Northwest Volunteer Inducted into Missouri Sports Hall of Fame

Frank O'Malley of St. Joseph has been inducted into the Missouri Sports Hall of Fame by Special Olympics Missouri. In a ceremony in Springfield, MO during the Opening Ceremonies of the State Summer Games, Frank O'Malley was recognized for his 38 years of service to Special Olympics.

During that time, he has served as a State director in two states, Georgia, when he was assigned to Fort Benning, and in Missouri when he was located at Fort Leonard Wood. Among Board the board members in Georgia was Rosalynn Carter, wife of former President Jimmy Carter.

Mr. O'Malley became involved in Special Olympics in 1973 while serving as director of sports for the Armed Forces. He remained active in the organization when coming to St. Joseph in 1985 after retiring from his Armed Forces position and taking over operation of the Budweiser distributorship, now O'Malley Beverage.

In 2003, Mr. O'Malley was a member of the Missouri delegation to the Summer Games of Special Olympics in Dublin, Ireland. Mr. O'Malley served on the Games Management Team and was very instrumental in getting the State Bowling Tournament brought to St. Joseph in which St. Joseph hosted it for 10 years.

Mr. O'Malley and his wife, Bobbie, are parents of three adult children, Kevin and Pat O'Malley and Kathleen (Mrs. Jim) Boldt.

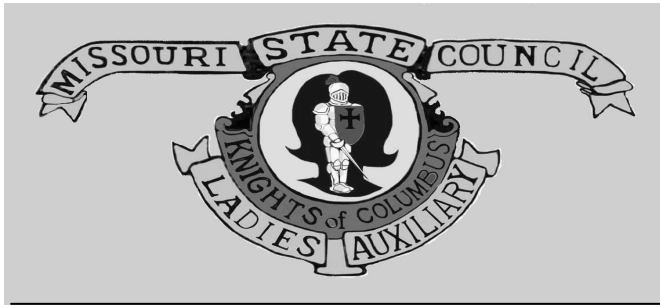

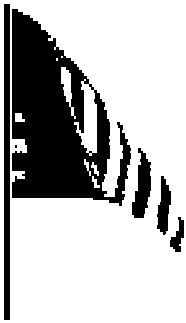
